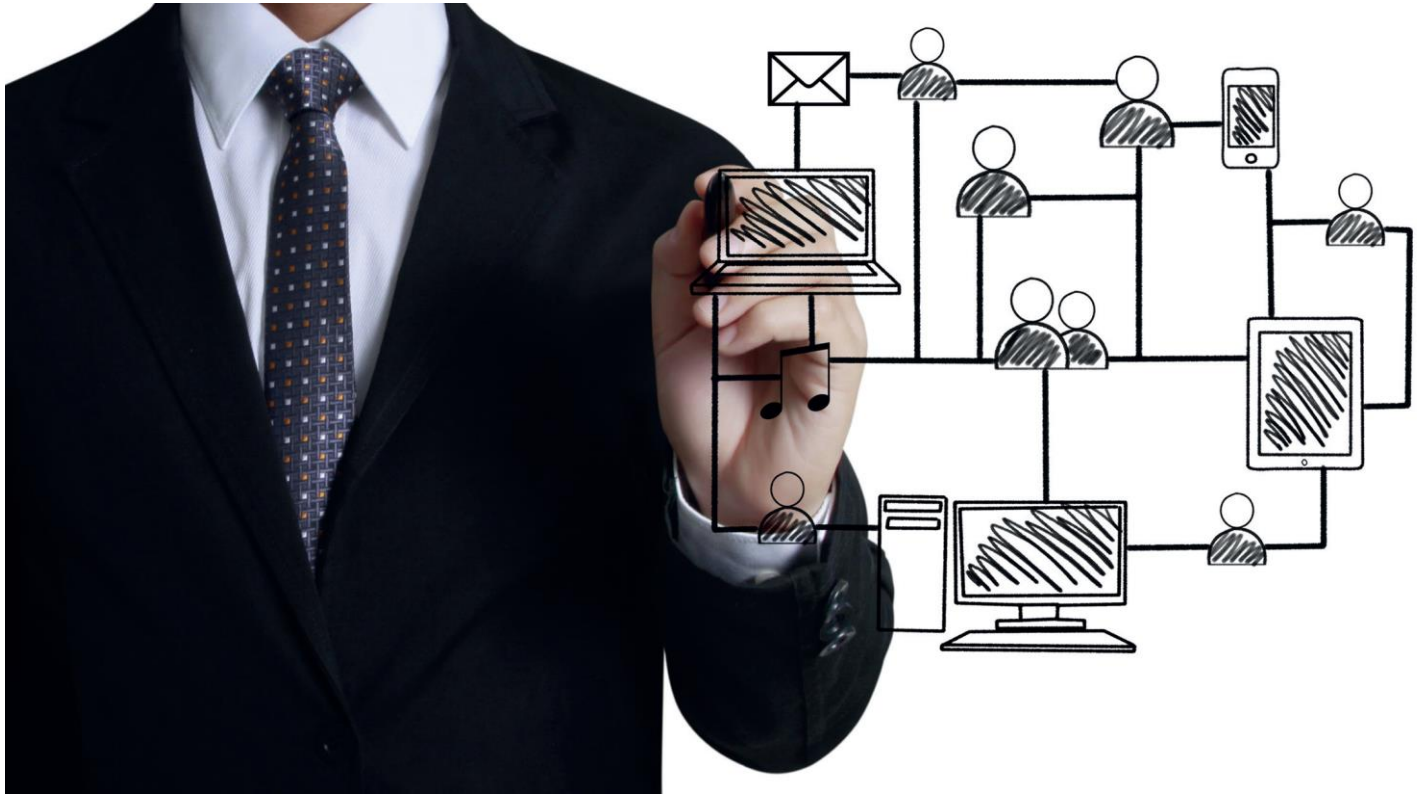


# MBA Management of Information Technology
