The Associate of Science-Registered Nursing program at Schiller International University Tampa Bay, Florida has been placed on student achievement show-cause by our accreditor, the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools (ACICS) due to material noncompliance with its licensure pass rate standard of 60%.

Tampa is no longer enrolling in the Associate of Science-Registered Nurse Program.
