President's Undergraduate Scholarship

Initial Eligibility	All Undergraduate applicants with a GPA from high school, most recent university attended, or Schiller (if most recent) at 3.50 or higher on a 4.0 scale at the end of each respective semester. Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Original Official Transcripts
Amount	Up to \$145/€112 per credit earned (up to a maximum of \$1,770/€1,344 per semester) awarded each semester after all grades are posted, not to exceed 10 total semesters.
Continued Eligibility	One (1) additional semester of continued eligibility is subject to maintaining an overall high level of academic performance by maintaining 3.30 CGPA or higher at the end of each respective semester. Students do not need to re-apply for this additional semester; eligibility is assessed automatically after completion of each semester. If one additional semester is awarded, students must re-apply for the next subsequent semester within all deadline and application requirements. If the CGPA falls below 3.30 (on a 4.0 scale), all future scheduled semesters will be canceled.
Eligibility for Re-applying after Loss of Award	The student may re-apply once the minimum continued eligibility CGPA requirement has been met at the end of their semester. The student has 7 calendar days from the last day of their previous semester to re-apply. Any application received after 7 calendar days will be applied to the following semester, in which the CGPA requirement must still be met. The school is not responsible for notifying a student when they have regained eligibility. Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay.

President's Graduate Scholarship

Initial Eligibility	All Graduate applicants with a CGPA from their Bachelor Degree at 3.30 or higher on a 4.0 scale. Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Original Undergraduate Official Transcripts.
Amount	Up to \$190/€140 per credit earned (up to a maximum of \$2,280/€1680 per semester) awarded each semester after all grades are posted, for up to 3 semesters.



Continued Eligibility	<p>One (1) additional semester of continued eligibility is subject to maintaining an overall high level of academic performance by maintaining 3.30 CGPA or higher at the end of each respective semester. Students do not need to re-apply for this scholarship; eligibility is assessed automatically after completion of each semester.</p> <p>If one additional semester is awarded, students must re-apply for the next subsequent semester within all deadline and application requirements.</p> <p>If the CGPA falls below 3.30 (on a 4.0 scale), all future scheduled semesters will be canceled.</p>

International Scholarship Undergraduate/Graduate

Initial Eligibility	<p>All Undergraduate/Graduate applicants with a CGPA from previous (most recent) education at 3.00 or higher (on a 4.0 scale).</p> <p>Must provide proof of cultural and social activities, volunteer work, contributions to society, and/or sport activities. Supporting documentation must be submitted with application.</p> <p>Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Original Undergraduate Official Transcripts, Supporting Documentation</p>

Amount	<p>Undergraduate: Up to \$80/€65 per credit earned (up to a maximum of \$960/€780 per semester) awarded each semester after all grades are posted.</p> <p>Graduate: Up to \$105/€85 per credit earned (up to a maximum of \$1,260/€1,020 per semester) awarded each semester after all grades are posted.</p>

Continued Eligibility	<p>One (1) additional semester of continued eligibility is subject to maintaining an overall high level of academic performance by maintaining the minimum CGPA requirements at the end of each respective semester. Diplomatic Scholarship

Initial Eligibility	All employees and their dependents of Embassies and Diplomatic Missions around the World. Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Original Official Transcripts, Proof of employment.

Amount	Undergraduate: Up to \$145/€112 per credit earned (up to a maximum of \$1,740/€1,344 per semester) awarded each semester after all grades are posted. Graduate: Up to \$190/€140 per credit earned (up to a maximum of \$2,280/€1,680 per semester) awarded each semester after all grades are posted.

Continued Eligibility	One (1) additional semester of continued eligibility is subject to maintaining a CGPA above 2.50 for Undergraduate / 3.00 for Graduate programs. Re-applying is not necessary for this scholarship; eligibility is assessed automatically after completion of each semester. If one additional semester is awarded, students must re-apply for the next subsequent semester within all deadline and application requirements. If the CGPA falls below the requirements, all future scheduled semesters will be canceled.

Golden Key Honor Society Scholarship

Initial Eligibility	Golden Key members are chosen for Membership into the Society by invitation only and apply to the top 15% of the university sophomores, juniors and seniors, as well as top-performing graduate students in all fields of study, based solely on their academic achievements. Students must submit an essay about what it means to earn your four-year degree? How do you feel this will enhance your plans and dreams for the future? Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Original Official Transcripts, Golden Key Membership confirmation.
Amount	\$3,000 (€2,400) per semester for Graduate degree programs and, \$2,350 (€1,880) per semester for the Undergraduate degree programs, for up to 2 semesters.
Continued Eligibility	Original award is good for one semester, with the potential of being automatically renewed for one (1) additional semester. To qualify for the one additional semester, student must have successfully completed each course with a minimum grade of a “B”.
Eligibility for Re-applying after Loss of Award	Re-application does not apply.

Employer Reimbursement Matching Scholarship

Initial Eligibility	Students that are eligible for tuition reimbursement through their employer. Must provide necessary paperwork from employer regarding tuition reimbursement program. Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Original Official Transcripts, Employer documentation.
Amount	Up to \$4,000 (€3,000) maximum per calendar year (January 1 – December 31). Posted to the student’s account only in equal amounts received and paid by the employer.
Continued Eligibility	Continued eligibility is based on student’s employer reimbursement eligibility. Additional employer documentation may be needed.
Eligibility for Re-applying after Loss of Award	For re-application requirements, refer to Initial Eligibility.



US Citizen/Legal Resident Scholarship (Florida and Distance Learning Campuses Only)

Initial Eligibility	<p>Must be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident.</p> <p>Must be enrolled in a Bachelor or Master degree program.</p> <p>Must be a new students starting after 7/1/2018. Continuing/re-entering students must have earned a CGPA of 2.5 for Undergraduate/3.0 for Graduate, or above at Schiller to apply.</p> <p>Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Proof of U.S. Citizenship or Permanent Residency.</p>

Amount	<p>Undergraduate: Up to \$177 per credit earned awarded each semester after all grades are posted.</p> <p>Graduate: Up to \$233 per credit earned awarded each semester after all grades are posted.</p>

Continued Eligibility	<p>All semesters of continued eligibility are subject to maintaining a CGPA above 2.00 UG/3.0 Grad.</p> <p>Re-applying is not necessary for this scholarship; eligibility is assessed automatically after completion of each semester.</p> <p>If the CGPA falls below the requirements, all future scheduled semesters will be canceled.</p>
